## 1. Apologies for absence

2. Resolution to exclude members of the public and press in order to discuss items of a confidential nature

3. To discuss the possibility and viability of entering into joint arrangements with Hodthorpe & Belph Parish Council for the administration and maintenance of Whitwell Cemetery, to discuss the contents of an agreement and to formulate any recommendations to Council.

The principle of establishing a Joint Cemetery Committee with Hodthorpe & Belph Parish Council was discussed at length, as was the draft agreement which was submitted for discussion by the Clerk.

The level of administration fee for internments and memorials to be charged by the council was also considered.

## It was **resolved**:

- to recommend to the council that it agrees in principle to the establishment of a Joint Cemetery Committee with Hodthorpe & Belph Parish Council subject to both party's approval of the draft agreement (attached to these minutes).
