

Walk directions

1. Turn right out of the Centre car park.
2. Fork right up Portland Street to the building with green painted window frames. **A**
3. Continue up Portland Street a further 50 metres to the steps on your right. **B**
4. At the top of the road bear round to the right and the houses opposite are known as Long Curtain Row. **C**
5. Continue forward and follow the road up Scotland Street until you get to the junction with the church straight in front of you. **D**
6. Carefully crossing the road, turn right and then immediately left up Old Hall Lane. As you get to the top of the church yard there is a building behind the church. **E**
7. Continue up Old Hall Lane and follow the lane until just before the main road. Take a pause here for. **F**
8. Turn hard right to take the well-marked footpath back across the field to emerge onto Worksop Road.
9. Carefully crossing the road at the little triangle turn left to walk down Doles Lane all the way to Arthur Short Close, the second turn on your right.
10. Turn right up Arthur Short Close and then take the footpath on the left, Mill Walk which leads you down on to Mill Lane. **G**
11. Turn left on Mill Lane and after 50 metres take the footpath between houses, numbers 36 and 38. This leads you onto Mill Crescent at the top of Duke Street.
12. Walk down Duke Street until you come to Welbeck Street where you need to turn left, carefully cross the road and then turn right before the garage onto the footpath across Welbeck Street Recreation Ground. **H**
13. Continue along the footpath all the way to Station Road and after crossing the road continue straight ahead towards the station car park. **I**
14. At the station car park here is some more history. **J**
15. Take the footpath onwards parallel with the railway lines to reach Southfield Lane next to the railway bridge.
16. Turn right and after crossing the road take the footpath to the right of Quarry Hill. Stick to the path as the path bends to the right to emerge on Franklin Crescent. Walk up the street to Franklin Avenue.
17. Detour to see the lighting of the Beacon at 9:45pm.
18. Turn left and continue forward towards the footpath around the quarry. If you climb up the bank to stand at the top, you should get a good view of the Beacon sited on the tunnel top.
19. Afterwards retrace your steps.
20. Walk to the end of Franklin Avenue to the junction with Bakestone Moor. **K**
21. Turn right down Bakestone Moor forking right down Butt Hill before taking the second footpath on your left to come down opposite the Centre.
